### **Eligibility Requirements for Hawai`i Alpha Delta Kappa Officers**

1. A candidate shall be:
  - a. an active Alpha Delta Kappa chapter member.
  - b. registered and attending the convention at which she is nominated, elected, and installed. An exception to this ruling shall be effected by a 2/3 vote of the delegate assembly.
2. A candidate for any state office shall have held an elected chapter office. A sustaining member, having served previously as an elected chapter officer, shall be eligible to serve as a state officer.
3. A candidate for president or president-elect shall have served one (1) term as a chapter president and shall have served at least one (1) term on the respective executive board as an elected officer or as president of the council of chapter presidents, OR shall have served one (1) term as a chapter president, shall have served at least one (1) term on the chapter board as an elected officer, AND shall have served at least one (1) term as chairman of a state standing committee.
4. Any office may be shared by 2 members. Service as a co-officer shall qualify as a prerequisite for future office.
5. State presidents and presidents-elect shall not hold a chapter office.
